### ***PTFA Christmas Fayre***

### ***Pupils on Site Before 8.40am***

The school gates do not open until 8.40am for pupils. As such there should not be any unsupervised pupils on the school grounds before this time. At 8.40am Breakfast Club pupils do go outside and the Upper School gate is open. At this time, older pupils in Upper School may come onto the site as they will be supervised by a staff member.
