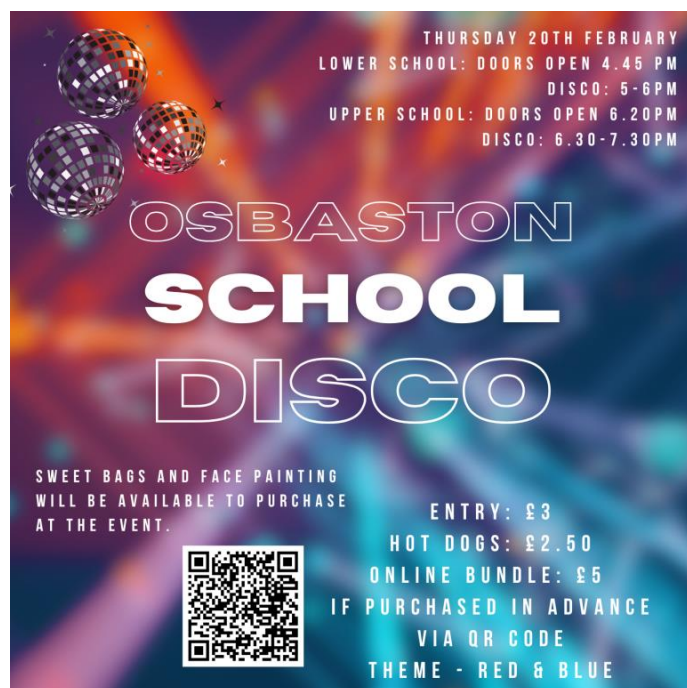


Newsletter 14th February
