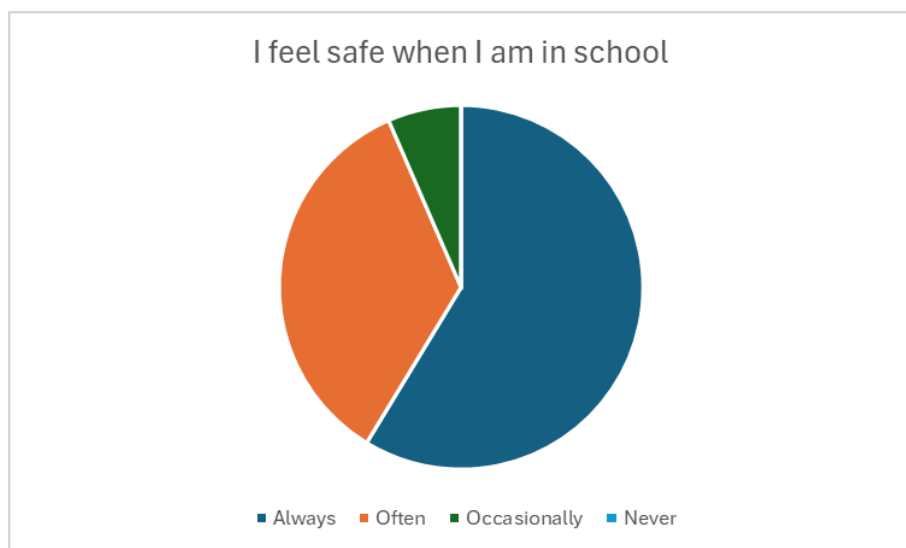
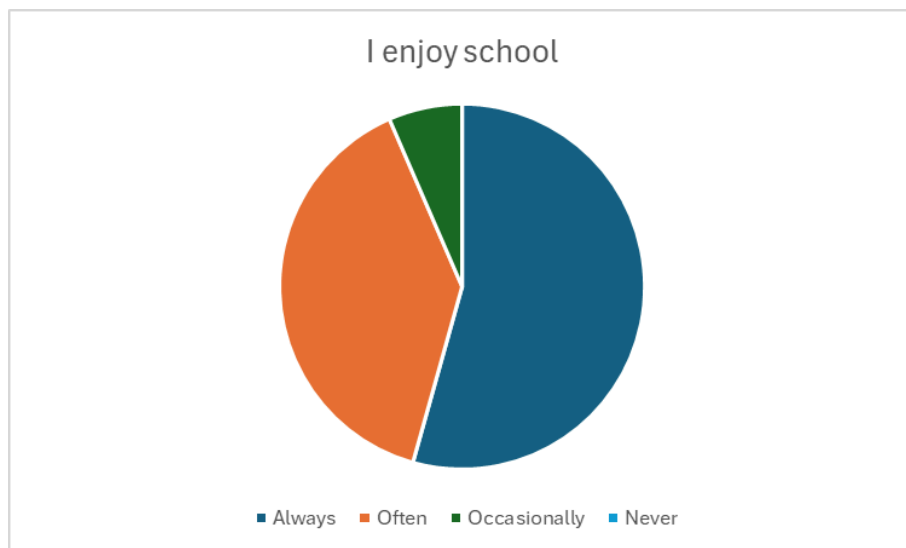
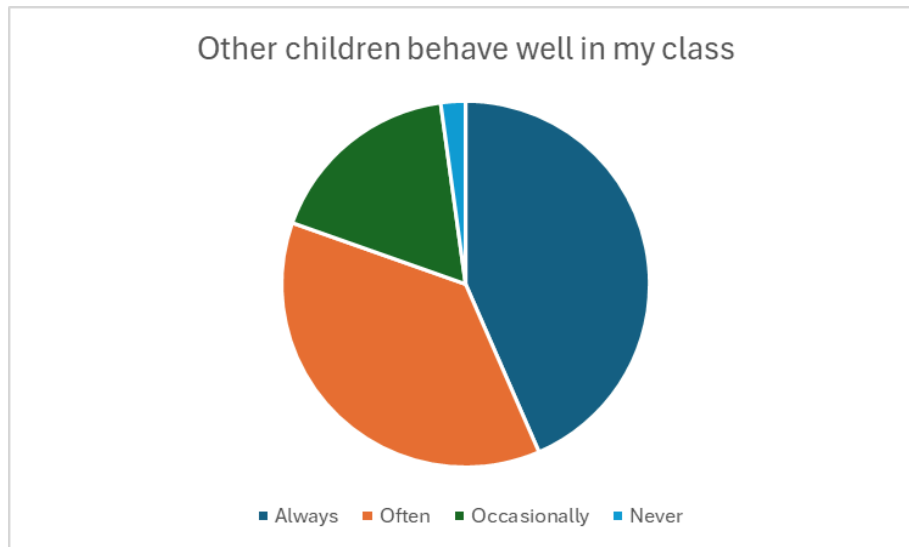


Year 1 & 2 Pupil Survey

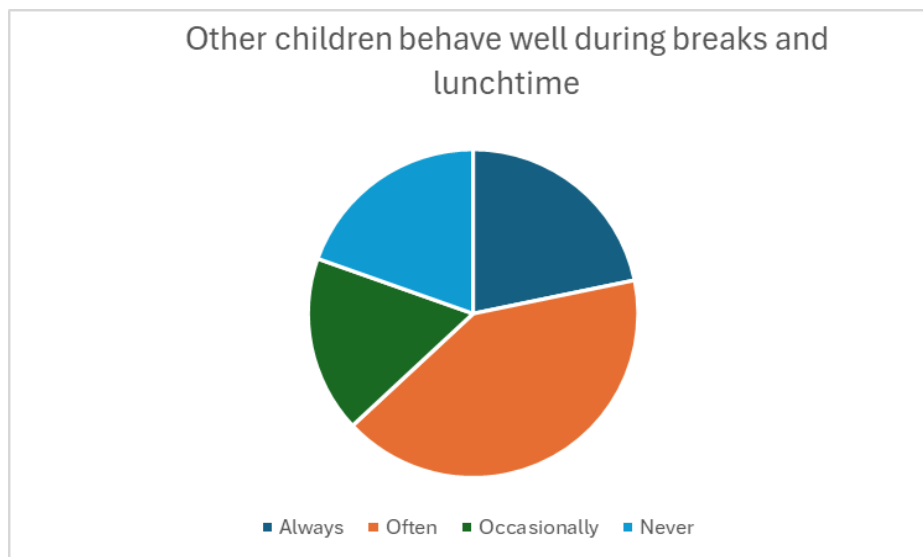

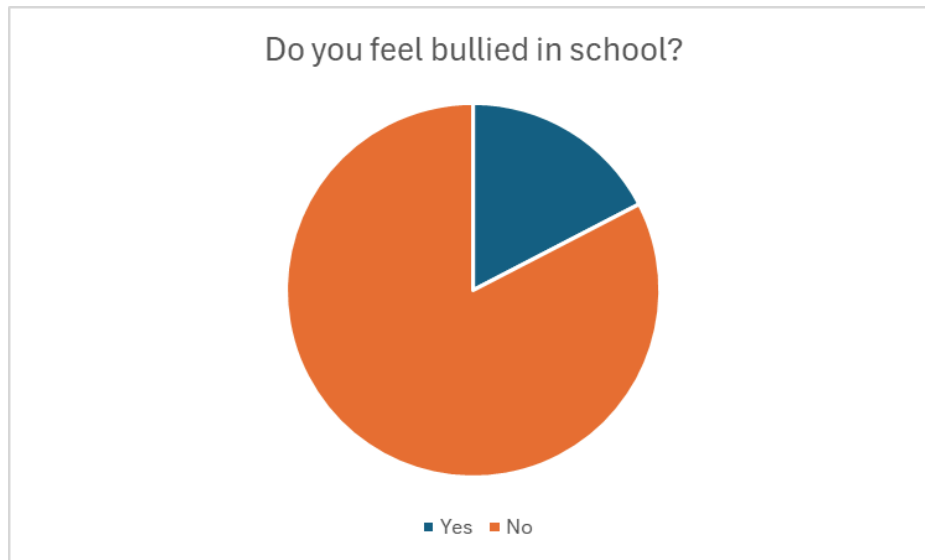
Nearly all pupils feel safe in school. Where some said occasionally, they were worried when the fire alarm sounded or they had to go inside and sit in the school hall.



Most pupils feel the behaviour of peers in the classroom is good with some occasional times when others may not share or help.

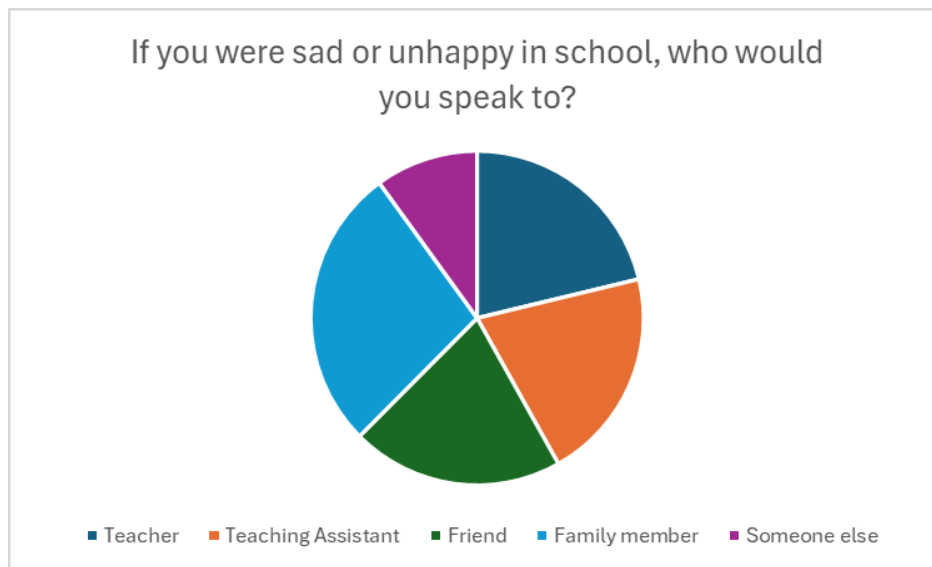


Pupils talked about times when others don't let them play or play games they don't want to play or are unkind. They also talked about times when others don't listen well enough, such as lining up or putting equipment away.



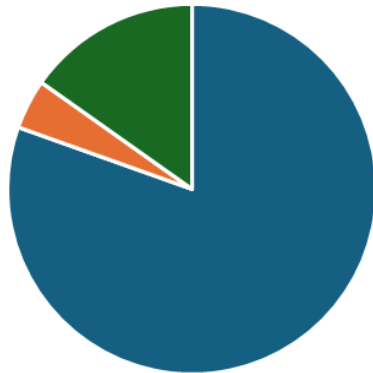
The perception of bullying was that there are times when friends leave them out of a game, or a member of the group is mean to them.

This was not recognised as continued occurrences and a sense of feeling very unhappy all the time because of others in school.



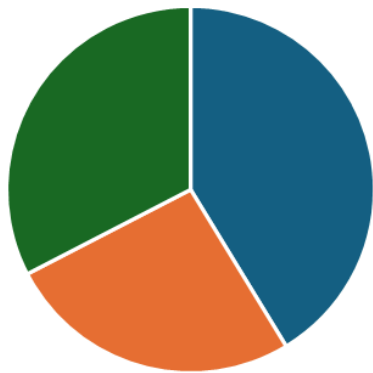
Pupils are confident to share with someone else when they are sad. Most would choose to tell their mum or dad, but would be confident to share with staff in school too.

I find my work in school....



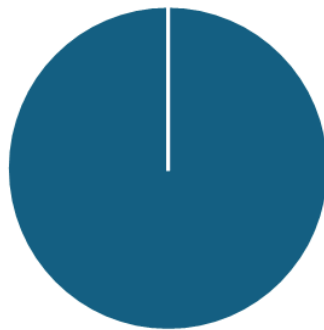
