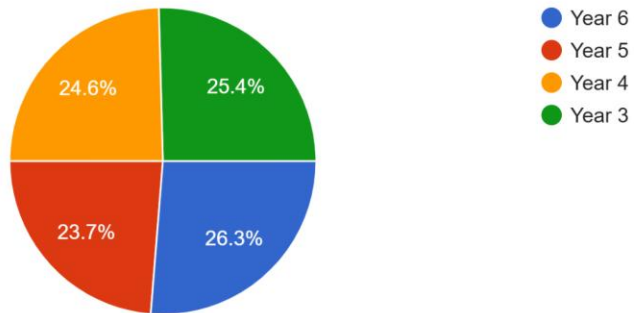

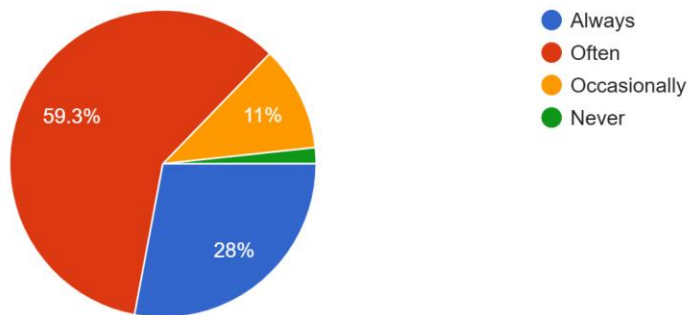
Which year group are you in?

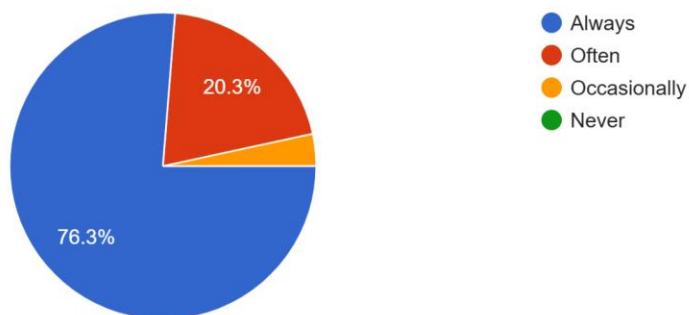
I enjoy school

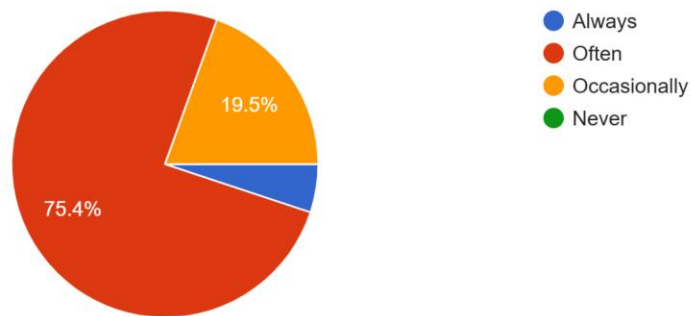
I feel safe when I am at school

Other children behave well during breaks and lunchtime

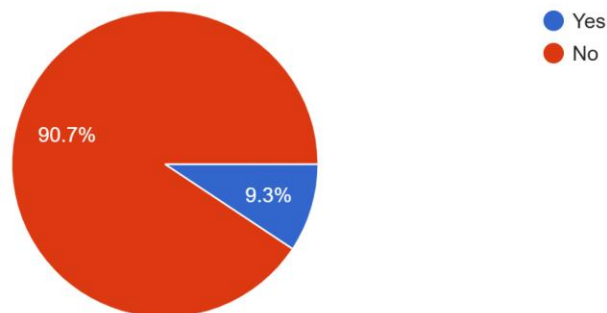

Do you feel bullied in school?

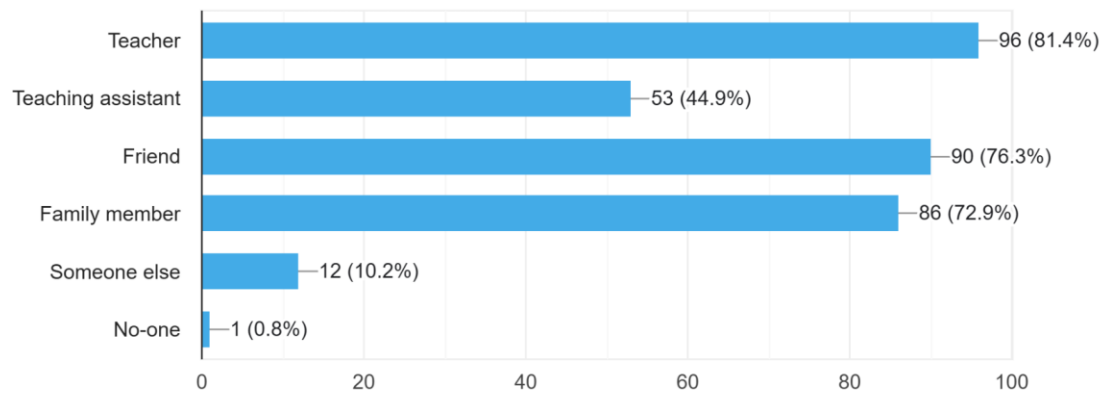

If you were sad or unhappy in school, who would you speak to? (you can tick more than one box if you wish)

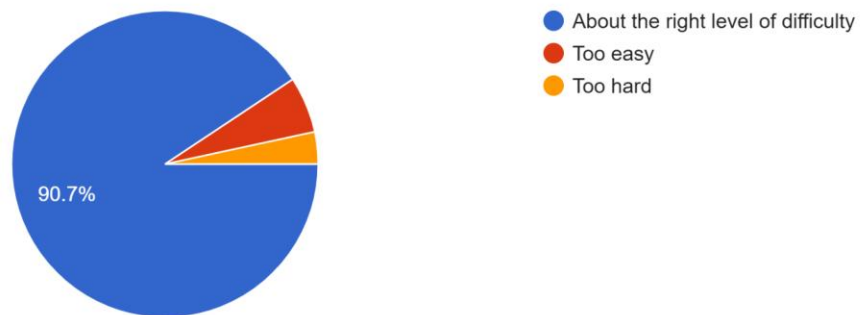

Nearly all pupils are confident to speak to a teacher if they are unhappy.

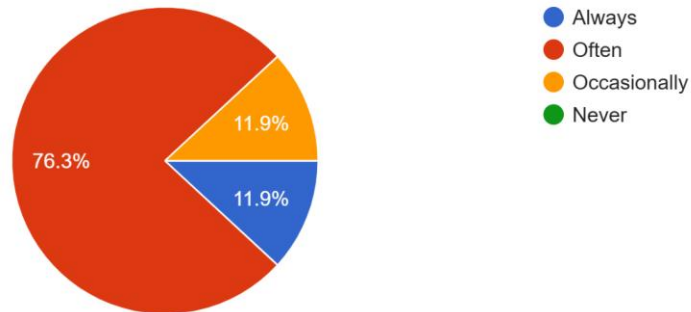
I find the work I'm given in most lessons...

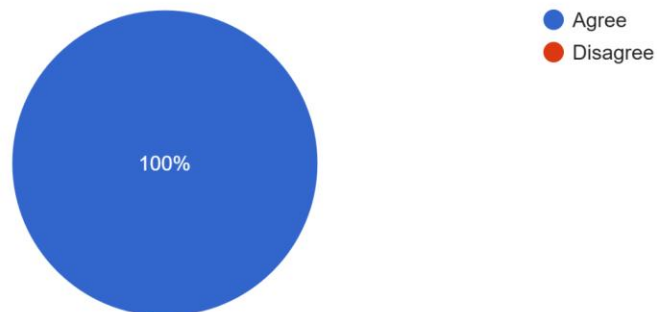
I find my lessons interesting

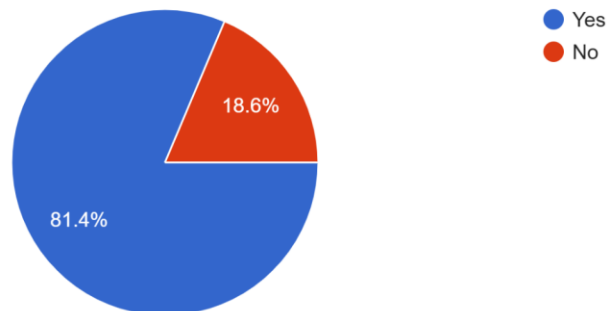
My school helps me to treat everyone fairly and with respect

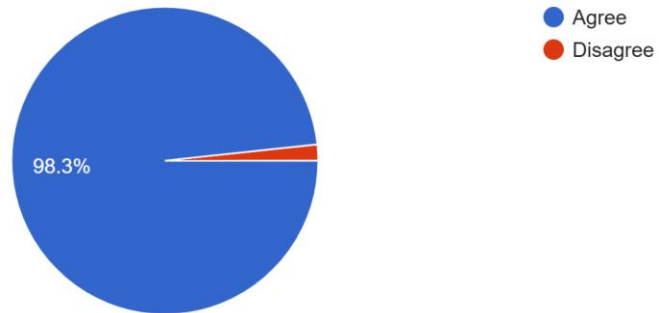
Adults in the school encourage me to take part in school activities outside of lessons, like clubs, sports, music or art
