Sir David Attenborough 100th Birthday Celebration

Our aim is to undertake a 'bio-blitz' which is where pupils will work together to identify as many species of plants and animals as possible in our school grounds. Our aim is to find 100 different species during the day, with different classes looking at different species.

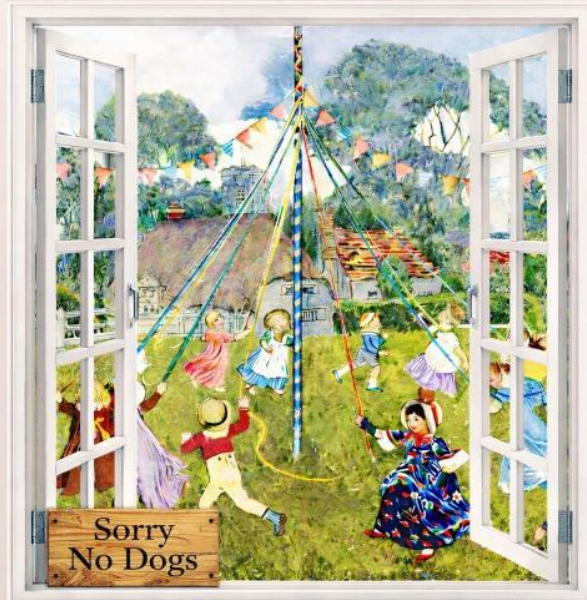
Stay & Play
