SupaStrikers After School Club

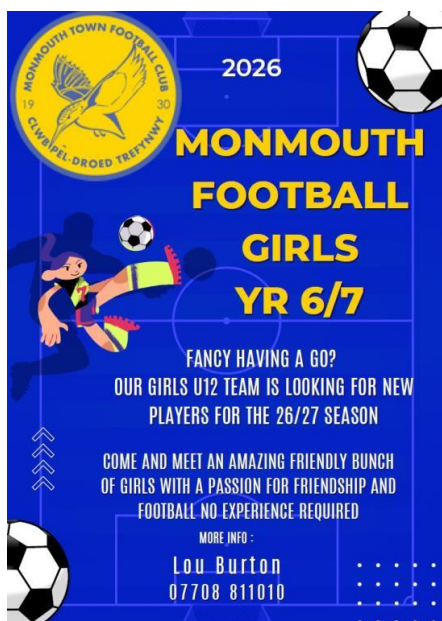
