Hair Tied Back and Ear-rings

Health and safety is paramount during PE sessions when pupils are using equipment or playing team games. With this in mind, it is important to remember our rules:

All long hair MUST BE TIED BACK (this is for ALL pupils). If your child does not bring a clip or bobble, they will be provided one by the class teacher.

Any pupils wearing ear-rings should remove the studs (hoops and dangling ear-rings are not permitted) themselves OR cover with micropore tape. If your child has trouble removing and replacing ear-rings, removal for PE days each week is advisable.

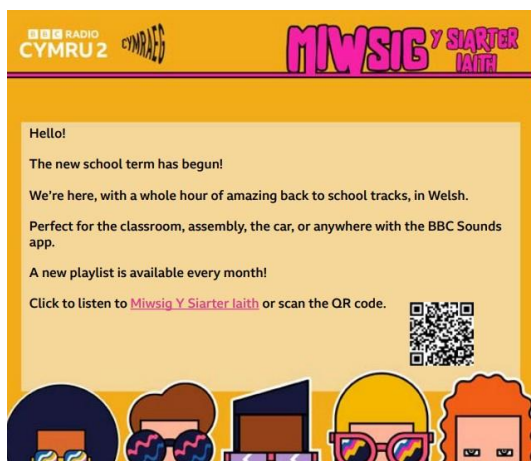
