Wellbeing Survey- Upper School Pupil

SHRN are an established policy-practice-research partnership between Cardiff University, Welsh Government departments and Public Health Wales. The school has agreed to take part in the SHRN Student Health and Well-being Survey this autumn term. The survey is being managed by IPSOS, on behalf of Cardiff University, and is completed online with support from school staff. Pupils in year groups 3-6 will be invited to take part. Participation is voluntary, and learners' answers are confidential and anonymous.

During class time, your child will be asked to take part in a brief online survey, which will take about 20 minutes. It will ask some general questions about themselves, their feelings, what they think about school, and behaviours which can affect children's health (e.g. physical activity, sleep, screentime etc). These questions have been developed in consultation with teachers, parents/carers, and children across schools in Wales.
